Police Report

Chief McEnerney related that the Glenview Club removed their Flock cameras due to budgetary issues. He also mentioned there was a backpack snatching at the train station last week (the woman had left her backpack unattended). One of the part-time police officers (who also works for a security company) offered to add cameras to the train station (gratis).

President Farr will talk to club leadership about the Flock camera removal (at the very least on Golf Road).

Emergency Services Department

Trustee Ross had nothing to report.

There was a discussion in January about the police bonus. \$13,000 was raised and \$9,000 will be used for the bonus fund, with \$4,000 for equipment.

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to approve \$9,000 to be distributed by the chief for the police bonus fund. Trustee Shine seconded the motion.

Finance and Administration Department

Trustee Miller shared that our financial position remains strong. He reported that we are behind on the property tax revenue due to a possible payment delay in Cook County. President Farr and Katherine Andrus are looking into the amounts and ensuring that our amount is correct.

Streets and Sanitation Department

Trustee Kalogerakos reported that a light pole was affected during a snow removal by Wayne, but the contractor will be taking care of the damage.

There were a few resident complaints during the snowstorm, but an email was sent around about the schedule and directing residents to shovel their sidewalks for clearer paths in the Village.

Utilities Department

Trustee Landman relayed that letters are being drafted to provide more instructions to the residents about what is needed for the lead service line replacements.

President's Report

Trustee Landman got a letter about participating (at \$1200) in the North Branch Watershed group, but we participate through Gewalt Hamilton, and we would prefer to continue that process. President Farr will also mention this group to the Glenview Club as well.

President Farr received a report from a resident that a Glenview home may be converted into a senior living residence.

He also relayed progress from the Village Prosecutor and any filings, however, no status changes have been made in the case being pursued.

Adjourn

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Landman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 pm.
