To start you will need:
2 coordinating fat quarters
1 yard lightweight iron-on Pellon
For the dino and race car Playmat:
fat quarter #1 cut 2, 2 x 18 inch strips and 1 9 x 12 piece
Fat quarter #2 cut a 6 X 18 inch strip and 1, 9 x 12 piece

For the princess castle play mat: fat quarter #1 cut 2, 2 x 18 inch strips and 1, 13 x 12 piece Fat quarter #2 cut a 9 X 18 inch strip and 1, 13 x 18 piece



Start with your mat handle fabric. Fold one side a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Fold the other side $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and press then fold it again $\frac{1}{2}$ Inch. Press.



It should look like this. Stitch down along the folded edge. Set your straps aside.



Take your pocket fabric. Fold open the tip and bottom edges. Iron and stitch across



Fold into third overlapping the edges. Stitch down both sides. Turn Right Sides out.



Pin your pocket to the center of your back fabric. Stitch around the outside edge of the pocket.

Pin the handles to the short ends of the backing. Stitch into place.



The back of your playmat is finished. To complete the inside of your playmat follow the directions to these tutorials. Then return to complete your Quiet Time Playmat.

Dinosaur Play Mat Race Car Play Mat Princess Castle Play Mat

To Finish your play mat, take the top and bottom of the mat. Place them right sides together.

Stitch around the outside edge leaving a 3-inch opening.

Flip your mat right sides out. Be sure to push your corners out. Iron the opening and edges if possible. Tip stitch around the outside edge. All finished!
