Expectations and Logistics

Please read all the information, with over 400 professional learning sessions occurring on August 6th, you must be fully aware of the expectations and logistics section.

- There are required and optional sessions occurring throughout the day and at multiple locations.
 - For the required content sessions (Math, Science, ELA, Social Studies), there will only be enough seating capacity for the designated content representatives.
 - If you are not the designated representative, there will be other content sessions and supplemental sessions to select from for your optional sessions.
 - Elementary schools will need to **designate 1 teacher per grade** level as a representative for each content area: Math, Science, ELA, and Social Studies. If a school has more than 4 teachers on a grade-level team 2 teachers can be designated to a content area.
 - K-12 Content Teachers will attend professional learning sessions at their designated locations for **half a day**:
 - Teachers will attend an opening session for the first 20 minutes, then sessions are a mix of required sessions and choice sessions. It is **required to attend choice sessions**.
 - There will also be virtual optional sessions occurring for interested teachers for the 2nd half of the day.
 - Select content areas/grade levels may have longer required sessions, reducing the number of optional sessions.

Professional Learning Locations

Schools are assigned a time and location, participants need to be sure to **attend the sessions that are assigned to them**.

Sessions occurring at Reagan High School, Parkland High School, Atkins High School, and Walkertown High School: Due to the volume of teachers attending each location, it is pertinent that teachers attending the morning sessions leave immediately at the end of their final morning sessions at 11:50, **parking lots need to be clear by 12:15** for the afternoon session teachers to arrive. Teachers participating in the afternoon sessions, **do not arrive before 12:15** to help with traffic and parking at the sites. **Register for sessions in the "Session Information" section.**


