**9:00 am:** Head out from Next House to check Walker for Tug-of-War rope, Chinatown for Pineapple Buns + Prizes. Budget: \$72.81

**11:20ish am: Borrow blindfold from diits,** Start moving everything from Next [blindfolds (4), whoopee cushions, parachute, balls, boxes, clipboard + paper for scoretaking, lychee jar] Grab stuff from McCormick (5 frying pans), Grab Tape [????] Calculating

### 12:00 pm: Outdoor set up:

- Sort and count balls
- Inflate Whoopee cushions
- Set up stations

1:05 - 1:20: Big Huggie: No points

An exec member calls out a number between 2 and 5, and people must get into a "big hug" with people from **different families**. Anyone who was unable to get into a big huggie is eliminated. No points are awarded, it's just a mixer/ stall for people who are late.

Materials: None

1:20 - 1:30

**Parachute Popping:** 

Points = 1-5 depending on ranking.

This game has been tested! Slightly chaotic but we think it'll be fun.

There's a big parachute, where we place x number (will be a lot!) of different colored balls (one color per family). We'll have 2 members from each family + 3 exec members (maybe the two social chairs + one rando) at the parachute "popping" the balls out of the parachute.

The other members of the family will be around the parachute (at most 3 at a time) trying to catch their balls that fly out. **Balls that hit the ground are out and cannot be used. If you catch another family's ball, drop it.** Once they catch a ball, they'll run to a bag to throw their ball in (each family has a separate bag) and another member of the family will replace them.

We play this for 5 minutes or until all the balls have been popped out. At the end, we'll count the balls in each bag to determine winners.

Materials: Parachute, ball pit balls

**Relay Races** 

Points = 1-5 depending on ranking

"Scallion Pancake Frying"

One person has a box on their back and attempts to catch the "scallion pancakes", another person throws "scallion pancakes" back to their family that were not successful.

Each family gets a frying pan and 2 whoopie cushions, and they have to flip the whoopie cushion into the box, and they switch off after each turn of "frying" until both whoopie cushions are in the box

Big/Little Wheel Barrow Race (obv big/littles not required, but encouraged) 3 pairs

Pineapple Bun Eating Contest

Materials: 5 Frying Pans, 5 Boxes + rope (if we can find some), 10 Whoopie Cushions, 15 Pineapple Buns

Round Robin System for matches

Materials: Rope

2:20 - 2:40 Fan Arena: Points = # of games won

There will be two simultaneous games: every family will get to play against each other once.

How the game works:

Each family will send up one person as the main player each game. The person will be blindfolded, and at the start of the game, will have to spin around in circles 10 times. Afterwards they will be free to move. Since the player is blindfolded, their family will shout instructions at them from outside of the arena on where to go.

The objective is to direct the player to pick up a paper fan (placed arbitrarily in the arena by social chairs) and hit the other player with it. There are two fans: one for each family. Using the wrong fan to hit the other player will not count, although if you pick up the wrong fan you can throw it further away.

The first player to hit the other wins!

Materials: 4 Blindfolds, 4 pieces of colored paper, tape

2:40 - 3:00:

**Splat Tournament:** 

No points

We're doing this while we calculate winners

Each family plays a game of splat

Rules here:

All stand in a circle, one person is nominated as "splatter" and stands in the middle. The person in the middle then randomly points at someone and shouts "Splat!"

The person they pointed at must duck, then the two people either side of the one who ducked must "splat" each other, by pointing the other and yelling, "Splat!"

If there is a tie, both participants do a "splat-off" where, after a count-off, they say splat continuously until one runs out of breath.

The last one to do so is out, this continues until there are only 2 active people left in the circle. When you are out, you go into the middle of the circle and call the next person. When the circle gets too small/too many people are in the middle, move everyone outside

Once you are down to 2 people, they will be your family representatives.

After all the families are done, there will be a group splat off where all family representatives walk off, shoot off style, and on the social chair's count off, will turn around and act like **CENSORED.** If you laugh, you're out.

Last family standing. Wins.

Note: Splat is tentatively NOT going to be played except for splat off.
