
How to fill out the Cañada College application

First, go to Application for Admission to College



Keep track of your OpenCCC login information – you will need this for subsequent semesters.


Click on the Start a New Application button.




Choose your username and password -- be sure to keep track of this information because you will need it in the next step when you sign in to the application.




The first page asks you to complete enrollment information. Choose *Fall 2026* for the term. Then choose *Complete credits for high school diploma*. Then choose *All Majors*, and for the last drop-down, choose *Gen Ed for Transfer to California State University or University of California*.



In the Education section, for the College Enrollment Status, select *Enrolling in high school (or lower grade) and college at the same time*.



Enter your current high school and use your transcript to enter your *cumulative unweighted GPA*. If you don't have access to your transcript, estimate as accurately as possible.

Student Residency Categories

Residency status is determined by the information provided by the student on the Application for Admissions. Students who do not meet residency requirements will be classified as non-residents for tuition purposes only. You are a resident if:

- You intend to make California home for other than temporary purposes.
- You have lived in California one year and one day prior to the start of the semester and meet eligibility requirements for establishing California residency.
- You have applied or received your immigrant status one year and a day prior to the start of the semester in addition to the above requirement.
