How it Works

Flock Friends is our top sponsorship tier for the animal program at River Jordan Farm, a site of River Jordan Network, a 501(c)(3). Your support fuels a program that:

- Provides eggs to local food pantries and service partners
- Hosts farm field trips, group visits, and hands-on animal care workshops (virtual and in-person)
- Builds the infrastructure we need to keep growing happy, healthy flocks

Your monthly or annual sponsorship covers the essentials of hen care. In return, River Jordan Farm donates eggs from your flock each month to a community partner, and we extend a 50% discount on all egg purchases made by that partner, subsidized by Flock Friends sponsorships.

Every donated or discounted egg goes directly to local families experiencing food insecurity **always at no cost to them.**

In addition to seeing beautiful chickens thrive and donating healthy eggs, by joining Flock Friends, you're supporting hands-on education, local food access, and mindful land stewardship practices in our community.

*Egg donations are administered monthly, with quarterly reconciliation to smooth natural seasonal swings. We maintain an “egg buffer” for these swings and other unknowns.

Community Partner Benefit

Thanks to Flock Friends donations (480 dozen/yr), our Community Partner’s effective cost drops to:

- **\$4 per dozen** on a blended annual basis; that’s \$6 per 1.5 dozen (1 doz purchased, 1/2 doz donated from Flock Friends).
- Comparable local retail pricing (Summer 2025): ~\$6-\$11/dozen.

What Sponsors Fund

- Feed, minerals, treats
- Winter care and bedding
- Veterinary care & meds · Biosecurity supplies
- Flock security (electric fencing, guardian dogs)
- Insurance & utilities proportional to poultry operations
- Coop maintenance and replacement infrastructure
- Carton inventory
- Starting new flocks for continued production
- Annual chicken-care workshop series, field trips, group visits, educational opportunities
- Partially subsidized egg purchase rate for community partners
- A lifetime of sanctuary for each hen on our farm

Accountability & Recognition

- **Reporting:** Community partners receive monthly production & donation tallies; quarterly roll-ups; annual impact statement, all published on our website annually.
- **Recognition:** Optional website listing, quarterly social media shoutout, or two farm visits per year
