

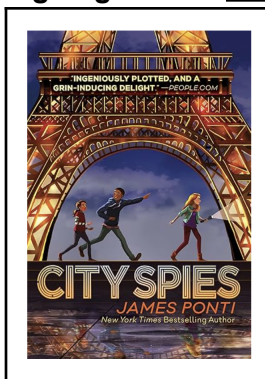


Summer Reading 2025 - 6th Grade
