Agenda Items & Notes:

School Updates:

- PPO was conducted on February 4th. The results were very good, and we received Effective and Highly effective.
- SBOs were conducted to move the PTC dates, so the next PTC is March 27th.
- Read Across PS 131: This will take place on March 3rd. Students can bring a teddy bear and will get to read stories with a buddy class.
- Festival of Colors for Diwali will take place on March 14th
- Career Day will take place on March 14th
- March 17th: School Spirit Day: Wear green
- March 21st: School spirit Day: Crazy hair day
- We are beginning the test prep after school program on March 4th. Students that are exempt from the ELA exam will remain in the Title 3 program.
- For 9 days, selected staff members will receive Orton Gillingham training in phonics.

CEP- Monitoring and Continuous Improvement Planning:

- MOY data is completed for all grades.
- Priority 1:
 - We are on track for meeting our goal of proficiency among ELLs in grades K-2 because 45.5% of students are proficient in reading.
 - We are on track for meeting our goal of proficiency among ELLs in grades 3-5 because 4% of ELL students are proficient in reading.

- Priority 2:
 - 22% of students agree that their classmates follow rules and agreements. Goal needed to be adjusted to reflect this data.
 - 73% of students feel happy in school. We are not on track at this time so the goal has been updated.
- BOY-MOY Data Results:
 - MAP is taken on the computer, so at times students do not take this test seriously, so steps were taken to ensure that they understand the importance of taking this screener.
 - Grade 3 increased reading proficiency by 6%.
 - Understanding Language Craft and Structure: 36% proficiency
 - Vocabulary: 3rd grade remained at 40%. Changes are being implemented to the process of how vocabulary is introduced and used in the classroom.
 - Understanding Key Ideas and Details:
 - Grade 4 overall went down 3% in reading.
 - Understanding Language Craft and Structure: remained 43% proficiency
 - Vocabulary: went down 3% so changes are being implemented to the process of how vocabulary is introduced and used in the classroom.
 - Understanding Key Ideas and Details: up 8%
 - Grade 5 went down 3% in reading.
 - Understanding Language Craft and Structure: up 4%
 - Vocabulary: remained stagnant at vocabulary, so changes are being implemented to the process of how vocabulary is introduced and used in the classroom.
 - Understanding Key Ideas and Details: up 6%
