ORDINANCE NO. 2025-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, ESTABLISHING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION WITHIN THE CRESTON COMMUNITY CENTER FUND (2042) OF THREE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$3,161.00) TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARIES AND SUPPLIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Creston wishes to increase the appropriations in the Creston Community Center Fund from \$28,210.00 to \$31,371.00 and;

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Creston directs the Fiscal Officer to supplement the Creston Community Center Fund in the amount of \$3,161.00 for this appropriation and;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer estimates that \$3,161.00 must be added to the Creston Community Center Fund if the payment of salaries and supplies are to be paid from that fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. That within the Creston Community Center Fund, \$3,161.00 shall be supplementally appropriated to the following account:
 - \$1,000.00 to account 2042-390-190-0000 Other – Personal Services
 - \$146.00 to account 2042-390-211-0000 Ohio Public Employees Retirement System
 - \$15.00 to account 2042-390-213-0000 Medicare
 - \$2,000.00 to account 2042-390-420-0000 Operating Supplies and Materials
2. That the Report to the Wayne County Budget Commission be provided a copy of Supplemental Appropriations increasing the Creston Community Center Fund.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency to have the ability to pay for supplies and salaries from this fund, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
