

Intergenerational Mentoring (IGM) – Parent Overview Season 2 (2025–26)

What is IGM?

The Intergenerational Mentoring (IGM) program pairs youth (ages 15–18, female participants) with trained adult mentors from Peace Tower Church. The goal is to encourage personal growth, leadership, and spiritual development through safe and intentional one-on-one mentoring.

Key Program Details

- Duration: October 2025 June 2026 (school year)
- Cost: \$30 for program (includes mentoring guide, training and oversight)
- Meetings: 2 times per month, one-on-one with a trained mentor
- Kick-off: Mentor Me Café October 4, 2025 (mandatory for youth + parent/guardian)
- Events: Midway Refresher (Jan/Feb) & End-of-Year Celebration (June)
- Parent Involvement: Parents are encouraged to join IGM too (paired with other adults, not youth)

Safety & Accountability

We take your daughter's protection seriously. All mentors:

- Complete interviews, reference checks, and vulnerable sector check
- Are trained in Plan to Protect and sign a Code of Conduct
- Never meet youth alone in isolation (sessions are in public spaces or supervised locations)

- Copy parents/guardians on all texts or emails (only between 8 am–7 pm unless emergency)
- Report any concerns of abuse, self-harm, or danger to authorities and church leadership

Your Role as Parent/Guardian

- Attend the Mentor Me Café launch event with your daughter (Oct 4, 2025) includes luncheon, training and specialty drinks; Cost: \$20
- Support her commitment to attend mentoring sessions and events
- Stay included in all communication between your daughter and her mentor
- Reach out to the coordinator with any questions or concerns
