The files requested for the application are:

- Cover letter from the doctoral advisor on the progress of the research project (mandatory information: name of the Institution, name of the doctoral program, name of the doctoral degree to be obtained, email address of the advisor). The document should not exceed one page.
- 2. CV of the doctoral student (must include email address) with a maximum length of one page.
- 3. Doctoral project document written in Spanish (entitled "Research Proposal") that summarizes the research design and/or its findings.

About the doctoral project document:

Topic, problem and research question Theoretical framework Methodology

Preliminary and/or expected results

• Submitted in PDF format, in Spanish, with an extension of 2,000 to 4,000 words (without references).



- The doctoral student and the advisor must be identified with their names, surnames, emails, affiliation and Orcid ID on the first side of the document.
- Abbreviations must be defined the first time they are used and must not be included in the title.
- The submitted proposal for the doctoral consortium does not exempt the author from participating in the presentations in thematic tables.
