3.	AMEND POLICY 5460 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (updated 2-15-21) The administration is recommending to amend¹ Policy 5460- Graduation Requirements that were approved on September 25, 2019. Transitioning the High School to a Trimester schedule will increase the amount of opportunities students have to take additional credits. We are proposing to increase the required amount of credits from 48 to 52. This transition would NOT impact the Class of 2021. The proposal is to gradually add credits each year to the Classes of 2022, 2023, and 2024. Full suggested change to Policy 5460 - Graduation Requirements. Impact for the class of 2021 and beyond.

- The School Board declared that PSD will be pursuing a voter-approved general obligation bond referendum to address essential and urgent facilities needs for February 2022.
- Superintendent Spicuzza and Supervisor of Facilities and Grounds is recommending the assistance of securing a Project Management vendor to assist in defining options for the board to consider in Oct and Nov. of 2021 that address:
 - i. The breadth of the project scope and repair and replacement of core equipment based on the SDS facility study.
 - ii. Outline realistic timelines
 - iii. Budget management
