4. A digital headshot photo (in JPEG format)

⚠ **Important Notice for Conditional Admission:** If you are conditionally admitted to the **Master Program in Remote Science and Technology**, your deadline is extended to **June 10, 2026**. Please note that **in addition to the 4 standard documents listed above**, you are required to submit either a **Financial Statement** or an **TaiwanICDF Scholarship Certificate**.

*Please note that if we do not receive your positive confirmation letter and required documents by the respective deadlines, your admission to National Central University will be cancelled.*

**2. Enrollment Policy** According to NCU regulations, a student who is accepted by more than one department/institute can only enroll in **ONE**. Therefore, if this applies to your situation, please choose only one department or institute that you wish to attend. The official Acceptance Letter will be issued after we receive your confirmation letter and all other required documents.

2. Your **verified transcript** with an official, original stamp/seal by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) Overseas Embassy or Mission.

*If the original diploma or transcript is neither in Chinese nor in English, a verified English or Chinese translation is strictly required.*
