Sophomores will visit several businesses and/or educational institutions (university, tech college, training facility, etc.) that support a specific career cluster of interest. Students will be able to interact with business professionals and post-secondary representatives in these places to learn about a variety of career pathways that may interest them. Students will be encouraged to learn more about these businesses and educational institutions before the day of the event, and they will have an opportunity to reflect on their day, as well as make connections to opportunities at OHS that support these career clusters.
