

AmPA! COVID-19 Animal Shelter Readiness Checklist

This checklist is meant to support shelters in devising a plan to be ready the moment a quarantine or shelter shutdown occurs, either for shelter staff or an entire community.

Immediate threats

- If a staff person becomes ill, the entire shelter staff may need to quarantine. If staff cannot come in to care for pets, shelters may be forced to euthanize animals and/or risk peoples' health.
- If a whole community is on quarantine, live outcomes through shelter adoptions, transports, and foster placement decrease, while the shelter intake continues, especially in a government-funded shelter.

The **COVID-19 Shelter Readiness Checklist** will help shelters to 1. maintain a lower than average sheltered pet census without the use of unnecessary euthanasia before a quarantine and 2. quickly reduce the number of animals onsite even further to accommodate the hazards outlined above should they occur.

Checklist

Has created an Employee Safety Policy Guideline.
Has communicated with the local Public Health Dept (if possible) on messaging to not
inspire panic, but instead, assure the community that the shelter is prepared.
Emailed all staff, volunteers, fosters, and supporters an update about COVID-19 and
how the shelter is ensuring preparedness in case of a situation that could cause a lot
of problems for animals in the shelter.
Dispersed the <u>AmPA! Coronavirus Shelter Preparedness Guide</u> to each relevant
internal department.
Met with teams to be sure everyone feels confident in their role in decreasing
intake and increasing live outcomes quickly.
Issued press releases to all local media outlets (tv stations, radio stations, and
newspapers) to urgently ask for help to empty at least 50% of shelter into foster, ask
for more emergency fosters to sign up in case of more need and donations.
Share on social media, including posting on Facebook
Put as the main theme on the shelter's website.
Ongoing communication with staff, volunteers and fosters (stakeholders) to ensure
that everyone has access to resources like the <u>Center for Disease Control and</u>
Prevention(CDC), Sheltering.org Toolkit, Rehome by Adopt-A-Pet
Signed up American Pets Alive! to receive more information, share ideas and ask
questions and report on progress.
