1 Your Support Will Always Be Used for Impact.

Your contributions directly fund our mission—whether it's **empowering youth**, **advancing gender rights**, **or ensuring education access**—and **not** administrative excess or wasteful spending.

2 You'll Always Know Where Your Money Goes.

Transparency is non-negotiable. We provide regular financial reports so you can track the impact of your support. As a registered **Section 8 nonprofit** under **Indian law**, we comply with all statutory disclosures, including:

- ✓ Annual financial statements
- ✓ Audit reports as per the Companies Act, 2013
- ✔ Public disclosures of key financials

3 We Honor Your Intent.

If you donate to a specific project, we will **ensure your funds are used exactly as intended**. If for any reason the initiative does not proceed, we will work with you to determine the best way to reallocate your contribution.

4 You Stay in Control.

- Want to donate anonymously? No problem.
- Want to opt out of communications? Just let us know.
- Mave questions? We'll always provide honest, prompt answers.

5 Your Personal Information Stays Private.

- We never sell, rent, or misuse donor data.
- We comply with India's Personal Data Protection Bill and ensure strict privacy standards.
- Nou can request to be removed from any mailing lists at any time.

💰 Tax Benefits & Compliance

▼ Tax-Deductible Donations (80G & CSR)

- Your donations are eligible for tax deductions under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (if applicable).
- Corporate donations may qualify as CSR spending under Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.
- We provide tax receipts for all eligible donations within 7 working days of the transaction.

Foreign Contributions & FCRA Compliance

- We only accept foreign donations through FCRA-approved channels (if applicable).
- Any international donor must follow FCRA 2010 guidelines.

Non-Cash & In-Kind Contributions

A. What Are Non-Cash Donations?

Anupam Foundation gratefully accepts non-cash gifts, including:

- Property & Real Estate Land, buildings, or other assets.
- Stocks & Securities Publicly traded stocks, bonds, and mutual funds.
- **Y** Equipment & Technology Laptops, learning tools, Al software, etc.
- Professional Services Legal, accounting, design, or marketing services.
- **Event Space & Supplies** Venues, catering, printed materials.

B. Acceptance & Review Criteria

- The donation must align with **Anupam Foundation's mission**.
- The gift must not create a financial or legal burden (e.g., costly maintenance, tax liability).
- Gifts above ₹2,00,000 require an independent valuation per Indian tax laws.

C. Legal & Tax Compliance for Non-Cash Gifts

- For donations above ₹50,000, we issue a formal acknowledgment.
- For gifts above ₹2,00,000, donors must provide **valuation documents**.
- If Anupam Foundation sells a donated asset within **3 years**, we must comply with tax reporting requirements.

Ethical & Legal Considerations

A. What Donations Anupam Foundation Does Not Accept

- Contributions that create financial, ethical, or reputational risk.
- O Donations from entities violating **Indian Foreign Contribution laws**.
- Gifts that compromise our independence or integrity.
- O Donations with **excessive restrictions** or impractical conditions.

B. Public Disclosure of Funding

- Major donors (₹10,00,000+) may be acknowledged publicly unless anonymity is requested.
- Corporate & foundation grants may be disclosed in impact reports.
- Anonymous donations will be reported as an aggregate total in financial statements.

C. Gift Return & Refusal Policy

- We reserve the right to decline or return donations that violate ethical, legal, or operational guidelines.
- If a conflict arises **after funds are received**, we may return the donation unless already allocated.
- The Board of Directors reviews cases where donation returns are considered.

Financial Transparency

- ✓ Our audited financial reports are publicly available.
- ✓ Annual Form 10B & Income Tax Returns are filed per Income Tax Act, 1961.
- ✓ Our accounts are independently audited under the Companies Act, 2013.

* Fair Compensation & Conflict of Interest

- ✓ Our leadership follows a fair salary cap policy.
- ✔ Board members must disclose financial interests & abstain from decisions creating conflicts.
- ✓ Staff and leadership cannot profit from vendor agreements.

- We do NOT:
- X Offer internships or jobs in exchange for donations.
- X Alter our mission to please a donor.
- X Engage in pay-to-play practices.



Restricted Donations & Refunds



🌱 Restricted Gifts: How They Work

If you want your donation to fund a specific program, we require:

✓ A clear purpose – Written intent of the gift.

- ✓ Mission alignment Must align with our values.
- ✓ No unintended burdens Should not create high costs or liabilities.

Gifts-in-Kind (Non-Cash Donations)

We appreciate in-kind donations, but may decline if:

- ✓ They require costly maintenance.
- ✓ They cannot be effectively used by our team or community.
- ✓ They place a financial burden on the organization.

Refund Policy

- X In most cases, donations are non-refundable.
- ✓ If a donation was made in error, contact us within 7 days.
- ✓ If a project is cancelled, we will offer reallocation options.

Public Disclosure & Ethical Board Conduct

- ✓ Major donors (₹10,00,000+) will be **publicly acknowledged** unless anonymity is requested.
- ✓ Corporate partners may highlight their funding, but not influence program direction.
- ✔ Board members must disclose any financial interests in vendor agreements.
- Nhat We DON'T Do:
- X Allow board members to **profit from contracts**.
- Offer favors in exchange for donations.
- X Engage in pay-for-influence fundraising.

Final Checklist Before Accepting a Donation

- ✓ Verify no conflicts of interest with board or staff.
- ✓ **Ensure funds align** with Anupam Foundation's mission.

- **☑** Secure donor intent in writing for restricted donations.
- ☑ For gifts over ₹25,00,000, obtain Board approval.
