Purpose and Role of the Board

PEIACL is governed by a voluntary Board. This group of individuals is legally responsible for overall governance. Generally speaking, staff members are responsible for day-to-day operations and decision making, while the Board provides leadership, direction and oversight through, for example:

- Developing long-term strategic plans and organizational policies;
- Making some of the bigger decisions such as approving the budget;
- Governing and guiding the organization while supporting the Executive Director; and Overseeing the organization's financial health, programs, and overall performance;

Individual Board Member's Responsibilities and Requirements

- Responsibly represent PEIACL to the community and to advocate for PEIACL mission and programs as appropriate;
- Support the organization through attendance at PEIACL events;
- Regularly attend monthly board meetings, AGM, and committee meetings as needed;
- Attend meetings well-prepared and well-informed about issues on the agenda;
- Build a collegial working relationship with fellow Board Directors;
- Available to serve the required term of office of a minimum of two (2) years.
