1. Welcome & Introductions

- **PTC Membership Drive:** 91 members joined so far this year, raising **\$2,905**.
- **Mailchimp:** 105 subscribers to the new PTC communication platform.
- **Corporate Sponsors:** 10 sponsors confirmed for the new school year.
- **Track & Cross-Country Jerseys:** Delivered to the school.
- **Mural Update:** The mural project is now complete, funded by the **Buckaroo Fund-a-Need** and PTC budget.

2. Public Participation

- No public comments or participation were made during this meeting.

3. Treasurer's Report

- Overview of class allocations and current PTC balance was shared with attendees.

4. Facilities Update

- **Critter Holes on Soccer Field:**
AL (District) noted this is a district-wide issue due to natural wildlife. Grounds crews will assess and level the fields as needed. Students should be reminded to be cautious when using the field.
- **Filtered Water Stations:**
Discussion around servicing the current water station (filter change), adding an additional filtered station, and possibly upgrading the lower playground fountain.
- **Multi-Purpose Building:**
Still under discussion at the district level as a future addition to the school property.

- **Lower Lot Parking:**
Faint parking lines have led to confusion, including vehicles entering through the exit. Repainting is scheduled in a few weeks. In the meantime, the office may be able to send a reminder about proper flow and use.
- **Back-to-School Stair Cleanliness:**
Concerns about dried mud on main stairs during Back-to-School BBQ. AL recommended submitting a work order this school year to ensure the area is cleaned for next year's event.

5. Teacher Update

- Staff expressed gratitude for the stocked refreshments in the teacher lounge.

6. Principal's Update

- Principal Connolly was unable to attend due to scheduling conflicts. Based on recent newsletters, the school year has had a positive start.

7. Upcoming Events

- **Fun Run (Bubble Run Theme):**
 - Planning in progress.
 - Seeking corporate sponsors so each student receives a Fun Run shirt and bag.
 - Families can also sponsor the event.
 - Leadership students may help bring new energy to the event.
 - Volunteer sign-ups coming soon.
- **Fall Fest (Saturday, October 25):**
 - Date confirmed.
 - Conflict with middle school dance resolved (now Friday, 10/24).
 - AL confirmed soccer games originally scheduled for 10/25 have been relocated.
 - Volunteer sign-ups coming.
- **Event Safety:**
A discussion is needed with Principal Connolly regarding prohibiting e-bikes, dirt bikes, and electric scooters at future school events for safety reasons.

8. Room Parent Update

- Due to platform restrictions, room parents have had difficulty accessing class contact info.
- PTC will consult with the office to retrieve contact data submitted during **Aeries data confirmation**, which includes an opt-in option for sharing with the PTC.
