SEEKING:

Young female performers for the Annie and orphan roles in a professional production of *Annie The Musical*, presented by The Tarrytown Music Hall and KJK Productions. Starring Broadway and New York City performers, this production will give young performers a unique opportunity to work and learn alongside seasoned professionals - live on stage for *Annie's* 50th anniversary!

We encourage performers of all backgrounds, ethnicities, and abilities to audition.

ANNIE: Female. Annie is a complex, tough, streetwise urchin who is surprisingly vulnerable when she thinks she might lose what has become most important to her: her newfound "family." We are looking for an excellent actress who can play motherly, independent, overwhelmed, and hopeful. She should be strong vocally and musically, with a vocal range of A3–D5 and be able to light up the stage in "Tomorrow!"

THE ORPHANS: Female. The Orphans are gritty girls - neglected and vulnerable, yet basically honest and lovable. Each actress should be able to shape her own specific character, be a good singer, and be visually expressive. They should be able to have "mischievous" fun together as well as "sibling style" fights.

Molly | Age 6 | Vocal Range: A3–B4 | The youngest orphan

Kate | Age 7 | Vocal Range: C4–C5 | Next-to-youngest

Tessie | Age 11 | Vocal Range: A3–C5 | The crybaby

Pepper | Age 12 | Vocal Range: C4–Bflat4 | The toughest

July | Age 13 | Vocal Range: C4–D5 | The quietest

Duffy | Age 13 | Vocal Range: C4–D5 | The oldest
