Guidelines for Reconsideration Committee

Under the best professional standards, reconsideration processes ask those charged with reviewing a challenged book or other resource to set aside their personal beliefs and evaluate the work in light of the objective standards outlined in the library's materials selection policy.

Listed below are some best practices for Reconsideration Committee members:

- Bear in mind the principles of the freedom to read and base your decision on these broad principles rather than in defense of individual materials.
- Based on the First Amendment, the freedom to read is essential to our democracy.
- Read or view all materials referred to you including the full text of the material in question, available reviews, and notices of awards, if applicable.
- Review the Needham Public Schools Library Selections Guidelines and the <u>American Library Association's Library Bill of Rights</u>.
- The committee's recommendation is to be an objective evaluation of the material within the scope of a library's selection policy.
- The committee's report, presenting both majority and minority opinions, should include a
 recommendation to retain the material in its original location, to relocate the material, or
 to remove the material.
