- Total number of new precincts is ~102, down from 248. Not all of those will need PCOs. We currently have 20 Dem PCOs
- Votebuilder has not yet been updated so I have not sent out your reports. That, along with more info on how your precinct has changed, is coming! We will try not to worry about who is where and what it is called at this point. We are all confident it can all be worked out.

- This coming May is filing date for 2027-2029 PCO term (we'll talk about this again as it gets closer)

What do we want to do and how do we want to do it:

- Those answers will be refined in the coming months. For now, we will focus on
 - Crafting a “communication messaging plan”
 - Including talking points, opportunities for deep listening, possible partnerships or info-sharing (e.g. Common Ground)
 - Individual PCOs use of such a plan will vary

- Some possibilities: contact “friendlies”; go down list and contact everyone with call or postcard; hold in-person gatherings; etc.
- We are reminded that it all begins with relationship-building and deep listening.. And that the time is now in light of the mid-terms and Congressional race
