Frequently asked questions about

Perry Hill School (PHS)

- What time does the day begin and end at PHS?
 The day begins at 8:15 a.m. for students and ends at 3:00 p.m.
- What time are students allowed to enter the building in the morning?
 Students are allowed to enter the building at 8:00 a.m.
- Where can I drop off and pick up my child in the beginning and end of the day?
 Drop off and pick up are at the front of the building.
 Students in the morning are dropped off in the loop in the front of the building. Please do not drop off your child directly in front of the doors. Pull all the way down to where teachers direct you to.

For afternoon pick up, parents are to park in the front parking lot and are required to physically enter the building, present identification, and sign their child out.

• Where does my bus drop me off in the morning and where is my bus at the end of the day? In the morning the bus will drop students off by the second floor gym. This is called Tier 1. In the afternoon there are two places to go to get your bus. Tier 1 will remain the same. Tier 2 is located in the back where recess is held. Afternoon bus pick up will depend on your bus number (It might be in: Tier 1 or Tier 2). Teachers will tell you where to find your bus. At the end of the day, teachers will direct you where to find the bus.

What specials are offered at PHS?

- **★**Gym- full year- 2 times a week
- ★Art- ½ year 3 times a week
- **★**Music- ½ year 3 times a week
- **★**Health 5th Grade one quarter once a week, 6th grade ½ year once a week

• What is a homeroom?

Homeroom is where students will always begin their day. Students will report there for attendance, morning announcements, and lockers.

Are I.D.'s used at PHS?

I.D.'s are used throughout the day. Students are required to wear I.D's on a lanyard. I.D. cards are used to buy breakfast/lunch and to check out library books.

What are clubs?

Clubs run the first three Fridays of the month. They take place during the first time block of the day. There is a special schedule the school follows on these days. Every student and staff participate in clubs. There are many fun clubs to choose from. Your teacher will review all of them and you will make your choice.

What are the lockers like?

Lockers will be right outside your homeroom. They are either purple or yellow. You will be able to decorate the inside of your locker with school appropriate materials.

• Will the students need to learn their schedules and the location of places?

Students will receive their schedule and their homeroom teacher before school begins. Students will have teachers and staff available to assist them with understanding what their schedule is and the location of places.

What is SSP?

SSP is known as Student Success Plan which occurs on the last Friday of every month. Students remain in their homeroom to complete activities such as determining their interests, creating SMART goals for the school year, learn about the different learning styles, kindness, etc.

Why is there a room called the cafetorium?
 The cafetorium is called that because it serves as both a cafeteria and an auditorium.

Does PHS have recess?

PHS does have recess. It takes place in the back of the building. PHS does not have a playground but there are basketball hoops, a variety of board games to play, four corners, and hopscotch. When the weather is nice there is a field that students can play on.

Will I have a chrome book?
 Every student at PHS will be issued a chrome book.
