*Role Play / scenarios

- Acting out how to ask if someone needs help (like cleaning up, or touching their items)
- Asking to hold a hand, to hug or a high five, etc - for peers and adults.
- Practice how to say “no” and how to respond when someone else says no.
- Lots of role plays opportunities in the top book mentioned.
