Shawn shares agenda items, Shannon report back on Stong towns, has been in partnership for about 5 years, looking at city and resources and how to make it better. looing at walkability. easily accessible to all. Sidewalks are terrible, signs and holes in the middle of sidewalks. towns built for cars, not for people on foot or bikes. Strongtowns.com gives a walkability score of town. Environment for walkability, trees, aesthetics, parking (convenient) safety distance convenience and comfort. research shows why walkable towns are more economically productive. put cars in their place, mix up uses, dual use places, parking rights, protecting the pedestrians. shape the spaces, make it pretty. pick the winners, take care of what you have. Visitors in conventions may help fund. poverty areas, nearest grocery store, Children playing in areas that are unsafe. having pantries available in areas that are less walkable. public transportation getting better but still not great. pair transit (on-call) route service. adding services to see where there is a need. Transportation is a challenge. border-board funding to help people fix sidewalks in front of privately owned homes. Where do we go from here, blue zones project, livability.org. vibrant .org. Jane Padgett blue zones have more centenarians. Shawn report back on Ontario projects.

The early childhood awareness campaign, Corina presents, a long-term awareness campaign. who is the target audience, providers, business owners, parents, city officials, teachers, public officials. the first 5 years are crucial for brain development. economic investment, High school CDA, Ready School, want people =to become aware of their own role in early childhood ed. survey stakeholders, **attached under additional docs.** Target each audience with different messages, providers spark rating, need to identify Champions, Americore Rare, RARE person may not happen. C2C Malheur be the champions in this campaign, everyone has a role to play. bigger than a social media post. Stable families mean Stable employees, we want to do the videos that will target specific audiences. People dont know what Quaulity childhood experiences look like. Coaching providers, show videos of what not to do along with what to do. it's a learning experience for all. what can we bring back next month? m Can we show some of the already made videos? simple flyers (did you know). We need a strategic plan, broken down or it will go nowhere,



secure funding for the campaign, start mapping out the plan at the Sept meeting. between C2C and equity stewards keeps it moving.

Malheur County created program vs existing program, which would create more flexibility within the program, and leaders/mentors. Lunch buddies, foster Grandparents program, need a large pool of people for different skill sets. big brother/big sister. 4h-extension, stem homework club. Agenda for next month, is this something, we want to dive deeper into? what is the goal? it starts before they go to school, parents and guardians are the first educators. must have a connection with family, not just students. need to partner with kids and parents.
