The Laurel School District will be operating on a Flexible Instructional Day schedule for Friday, Feb 4, 2022. Schools will start instructing virtually following a 2 hour delay schedule.

The 2 hour delay will allow families to make necessary arrangements due to the change in schedule. It will also allow for a period of planning on the part of the teachers to adapt their lessons to a virtual environment.

Students will be required to log on to their device and participate in classes in order to receive their attendance credit for the day. If a student does not log on and participate he/she will be marked absent excused.

Instructional staff has the option to work from home or utilize the school. The building will be open for teachers to utilize our wifi or any other resource they may need that is unique to their room.

All activities will be cancelled for Friday. No practices, games or the like.

I am asking that instructional staff use safety as their guide. If instructional staff are concerned about safely reporting to work, they may conduct class from home. Otherwise, the option to report to the classroom exists.
