

Choir Fees and How to Pay

Annual Fees (for every choir member) **\$135**

Choir fees cover items that are needed throughout the school year. A specific breakdown of choir fees will be discussed at the Choir Parent Meeting on Thursday, September 4th.

Additional One-Time Fees

These one-time fees are only for 9th graders and new TWHS choir members. They are in addition to the **\$135** annual fee.

2. Spring Trip to Orlando - April 23-27 - Cost: \$2067.00

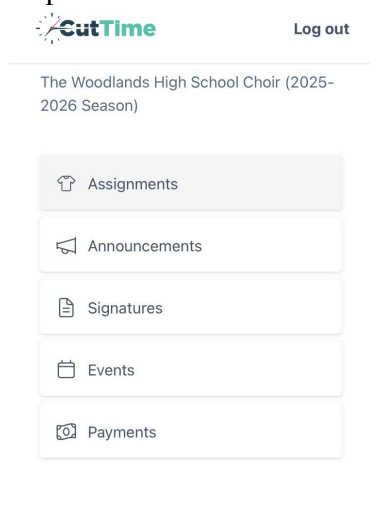
Optional Fees

2. Spirit Wear – Various Options TBA

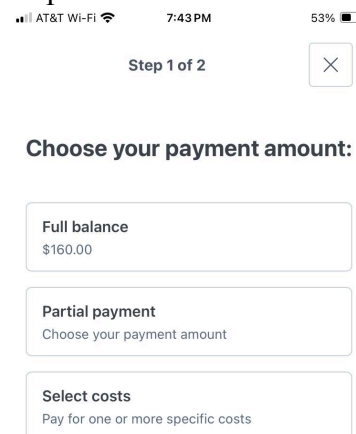
Two ways to pay your choir fees: 1) Online 2) Cash or Check

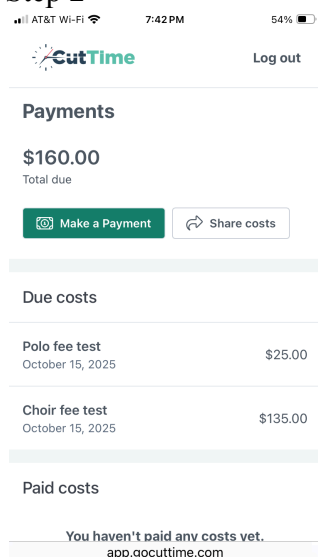

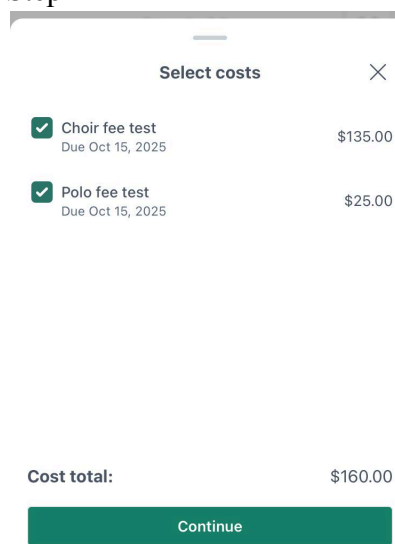

2) **Cash or Check**

- Checks should be written to “The Woodlands HS Choir Booster Club” and placed in an envelope with your student’s name on the front and a description of the payment.
(Example: Harry Potter’s Annual Choir Fee and Choir Polo-\$160)
- Payments should be dropped in the Booster Drop Box in the choir room at either campus. Please allow 1-2 weeks for updates to CutTime to reflect fees are paid
- Note: *In the event that the student’s name is missing, we’ll make a considerable effort to identify the student. However, if we are unsuccessful, and if the payment was made*

in cash, the total amount will be considered a donation. If paying in cash, please include the exact amount as we are not able to make change.
