

## **Stamp Student Union - Stamp Programs Travel Policies:**

All students who travel with Stamp Programs are expected to maintain the highest standards of professional conduct and integrity. Students must comply with all College and University policies and procedures (see the University of Maryland Code of Student Conduct)

Conduct yourself as a law abiding member of both the UMD community and our broader society – including but not limited to a) refraining from behaviors that infringe upon the rights of others or disrupt the educational process, and b) acting in conformity with UMD and Stamp policies and public law.

As participants in school-sponsored travel, students are expected to commit to the following:

- Participants under the age of 21 may not possess or consume alcoholic beverages.
- Participants may not possess or use drugs, or tobacco.
- Participants may not possess or use weapons such as firearms, fireworks, knives, etc.
- Participants will be attentive, respectful, responsive, and courteous to all fellow program participants, Trip leaders, activity staff, speakers, etc.
- Participants will respect the rights and feelings of others at all times.
- Participants will handle public and private property respectfully at all times.
- Participants will return to the designated gathering point on or before the time indicated by the Trip Leader.
- Participants will abide by any and all verbal and/or written instructions issued by the Trip Leader, Staff, Motorcoach driver, etc..
- Participants traveling with the Motorcoach must arrive with us and leave us. Participants are not allowed to leave with us if they did not ride with us.
- No minors are allowed on the trips 18+
