

One Pager Directions

A one pager is a way to visually share key ideas and information from what you have learned. When you create a one pager, you are trying to use both visual symbols and important words to clearly and concisely share your most important takeaways with someone else, even if they have no previous knowledge on the topic. Use your textbook, notes, US History in Context or other reputable website to gather information and/or images.

For this one pager, I've provided you with a template.

Here's what it MUST INCLUDE:

TOPIC (THE NEW DEAL) in the CENTER BOX

- A border which somehow represents key ideas (words or images) about The New Deal or The Great Depression.
- Label the upper left hand corner **Relief**. Define what a relief program does. List at least **two relief programs**. Include an image that represents what you consider to be the most important idea about **relief programs**.
- Label the upper right hand corner **Reform**. Define what a reform program does. List at least **two reform programs**. Include an image that represents what you consider to be the most important idea about **reform programs**.
- Label the lower left hand corner **Recovery**. Define what a recovery program does. List at least **two recovery programs**. Include an image that represents what you consider to be the most important idea about **recovery programs**.
- Images and/or words in the bottom right hand corner that address the **impact** the New Deal programs had. Include impact on **people, industry, and the economy**.

You may also add other symbols, drawings, and words that represent the New Deal as you wish.
