Objectives:

To partner with Pastor and director of youth and family ministry to serve and represent the children of Faith Lutheran, from infancy to High School.

Responsibilities:

- Provide an organized system of spiritual growth which includes education opportunities and material consistent with the theology of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America.
- Work with other council/committee members to encourage participation and involvement of youth in worship.
- Annually appoint and assist in recruitment of personnel for the following coordinators and sub-committees: Nurture, Sunday School, VBS, WNL, Youth Group, Middle school and High school outings.
 - Nurture
 - Keep children activities (welcome bags and toys) for youth during church up to date.
 - Occasionally check in on the Nursery room to make sure toys are in good standing.
 - Compile Christmas bags and distribute at Christmas Eve Service.
 - Sunday School, VBS, WNL
 - Provide training opportunities for teachers in cooperation with the youth director.
 - Aide in keeping attendance of program statistics.
 - Aide in annual budget.
 - Youth Group/Middle school and High School outings
 - Aide in providing regular gatherings for opportunities for spiritual strengthening and fellowship and ensuring these opportunities and activities support and contribute to the mission statement of FLC.
 - Aide in budgeting for these activities.
- Utilize appropriate channels of communication to ensure all opportunities are made available to all Youth and Adult Volunteers that are eligible to participate in.
- Attend Church council meetings and report on Youth activities and budget.
