



SECONDstage Competition

SECOND STAGE

This is an event that takes place during the weekend festival.

Second Stage is an 8 minute scene presentation competition (2 min setup/strike). Fall adjudicated schools, who are attending Festival weekend may sign up to be part of this event held on Saturday of the High School Theatre Festival. The winner will perform on the main stage during the award ceremony.

Adjudicated Southern Schools are eligible for the Second Stage Competition based upon the following criteria:

- Your adjudicated fall production was not chosen for a MainStage spot or the Festival of Scenes (1st, 2nd or 3rd place).
- All participants have paid registration for the weekend festival.

Guidelines are as follows:

Reservations will be taken after the winners of MainStage (1st Place) and Festival of Scenes (2nd and 3rd Place) are announced, usually after the first week of December. Reserve your spot by visiting:

- Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis.

- There are sixteen (16) spots open (eight (8) for each session). Once these are filled, a “waiting list” will be started in case a school(s) drops out.
- A school may enter ONE (1) scene. The maximum time limit is eight (8) minutes. Schools risk disqualification if their scene exceeds eight (8) minutes.
- The final date for Second Stage entries is December 31st.
- Each student must have a paid ticket to the weekend festival.
- You must have all of the following information in order for your entry to be accepted – no exceptions. If your information is incomplete, you get “bumped” until your info is complete.
 1. Title of Play or Title of Scene
 2. Author
 3. Director
 4. Full name of Actors with their Character names, and an identifying factor.
