3. Club & School Affiliation

Clubs and schools do not have to be affiliated with Perth Reds Volleyball Association (PRVA) to play in the Perth Reds Indoor Youth Volley League (YVL).

4. Team Nomination & Game Fees

All Clubs and Schools will be required to nominate via the PRVA Website. Late nominations will be only accepted if it benefits the league. Team nomination & nomination fees due dates are specified in the PRVA Indoor Youth Volley League 2024 Key Dates Document.

Each Club / School can nominate several teams in the Yr 3-6 mixed division.

All team nomination fees and team game fees (including finals) for all club/school teams will be invoiced to the club/school. All fees are expected to be paid by return invoice unless otherwise arranged with PRVA. Penalties will apply if payments are not made on time, this could include fines and forfeiture of games. Game Fee due dates are specified in the 2024 YVL Key Dates Document.

4.1 Withdrawals

If a club/school withdraws a team prior to and including round two of the competition, the Club will forfeit the Nomination Fee and the Games Fees for the first two rounds.

If a club/school withdraws a team after round two of the competition, all nomination fees for that team are payable as well as any additional administration and game fees. This will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

5. Membership

All athletes and coaches are required to be registered with the club or school for which they are participating.

6. Player Eligibility

6.1 School Students

Athletes playing in a school nominated team must attend the school they are nominated to play under. Any exemptions to this must be cleared by the Tournament Director.

7. YVL Kids Competition Structure

7.1 Division Structure

All divisions will have at least 4 teams.

Divisions with a large number of teams will be split into 2 pools at the Tournament Director's discretion.

7.2 Match Format

7.2.1 Round Matches and Finals Rounds (except Grand Final):

- To a 30min time limit.
- Best of 3 sets. All sets, point per rally to 21 points uncapped. Must lead by 2 points minimum.
- 1 time out per set and no time outs in the last 5 minutes of the match.
- If only 1 set is completed at the end of time, the team that has won the first set will be awarded the match. Incomplete second sets will not be counted.
- Incomplete sets are only considered in the final result when set scores are tied (i.e. third set only, deciding set).

- Deciding set:
 - In the case of a deciding third set being unfinished at the end of the time limit, the team holding 8 or more points, with a 2-point lead, will be awarded the set and thus the match.
 - If a team holds 8 or more points at time without a 2-point lead, the match will continue until a 2-point lead is achieved.
 - If neither team has reached 8 points, the match is declared a draw.

7.2.2 Grand Final only

- Untimed game.
- Best of 3 sets. All sets, point per rally to 21 points uncapped. Must lead by 2 points minimum.

7.3 Match Times

All matches will be played on Friday nights. Matches will be run in 30min timeslots - 5:30pm and 6:00pm.

7.4 Net Height and Court Size

The standard net height is 2m (0 holes showing). Court size is the outer lines of a badminton court.

7.5 Player Numbers and Substitutions

There is a maximum of 4 players on the court at any time and a minimum of 3.

A maximum of 10 players are allowed to a team.

Rotating substitutions occur after a team wins the serve.

7.6 Premiership Points

Points for all Divisions in YVL will be allocated in the following manner.

Result	Points
Win	3 points
Draw	1 point
Loss	0 points
<i>Forfeits</i>	
Administrative Forfeit	-1 point
Failure to field a side on the night	-2 points

7.7 Ladder Placings

Positions will be determined by premiership points average (rounded to four decimal places), then by sets won percentages (rounded to four decimal places), then by points won percentages (rounded to four decimal places). Premiership points average will be calculated by premiership points/games played.

7.8 Finals Format

If a division has more than one pool, then a cross over finals format will apply. The top two teams from each pool will progress to finals.

8. Rules, Referees & Coaches

8.1 Rules of the Game

Referees will referee according to the current Official FIVB/VA Volleyball Rules with additional rules adapted for YVL-Kids stated below.

All players are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner in accordance with the Volleyball Rules and abide by the PRVA Member Protection Policy Codes of Conduct.

8.1.1 Serving

Second chance serves - If there is a service error, players are allowed to take one step forward and have a second chance.

Three successful serves - After 3 successful serves, a team will rotate but will retain the serve. Teams earn the right to serve by winning the rally.

8.1.2 Ball Handling

The ball must be hit cleanly and may not be thrown, caught or scooped.

The ball may legally contact any part of the body. Kicking the ball is illegal.

Players may not make two consecutive hits of the ball.

Teams have three contacts to get the ball over the net. A block does not count as a contact.

8.2 Referees

All referees are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner in accordance with the Volleyball Rules and abide by the PRVA Member Protection Policy Officials Code of Conduct.

All referees will be appointed by PRVA. YVL Kids will have one referee per game. The role of the referee includes completing the scoresheets.

The referee is required to be present on court for the start of the warm-up. The referee is also responsible for ensuring that all bags etc. are placed under the chairs at the back of the court and bench areas are clean and tidy at the completion of the game.

All referee and coordinator payments will be processed on an honorarium basis. All PRVA payment information forms need to be completed prior to payments being made (available from the Tournament Director).

8.3 Coaches

All coaches are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner in accordance with the Volleyball Rules and abide by the PRVA Member Protection Policy Coaches Code of Conduct.

A qualified coach/teacher/team manager must be responsible for the team for the duration of the game. The person responsible for the team must be over 18 years old.

This person must not be a player rostered on the team. This includes from the commencement of the warm-up period to the completion of the game.

9. YVL Kids Review

The YVL Kids Competition & Regulations Handbook is to be reviewed annually. All requested changes to the Competitions and Regulations Handbook are to be submitted in writing to the PRVA Competitions Director (competitions@redsvolley.com).

10. Member Protection

PRVA is a Child Safe Organization which aims to safeguard the well-being of all children and young people who participate in our sport. All participants, officials and staff are required to comply with the PRVA Child Safeguarding Policy and abide by the PRVA Codes of Conduct.

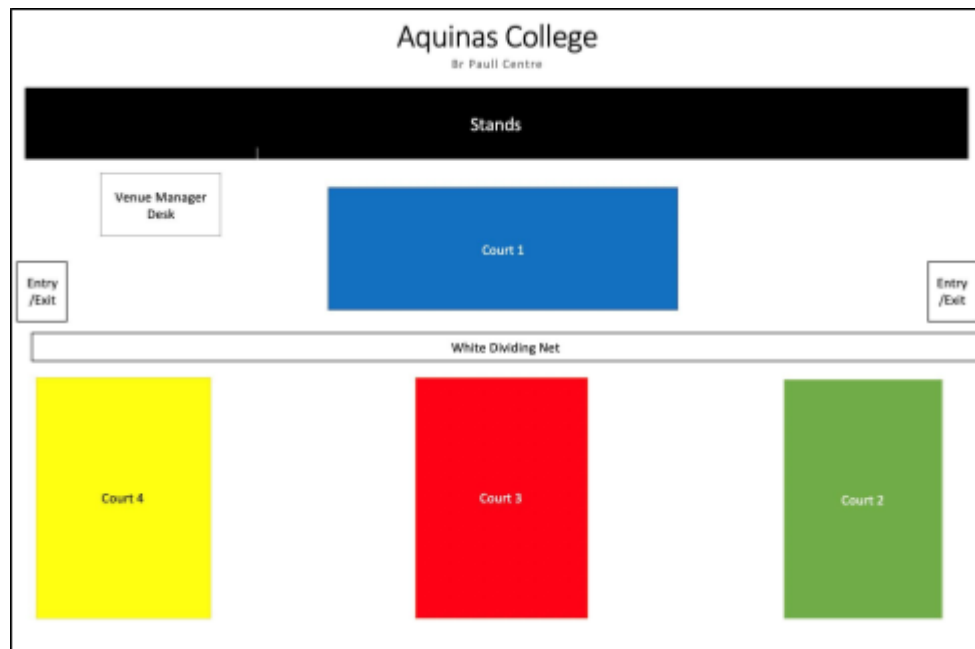
