

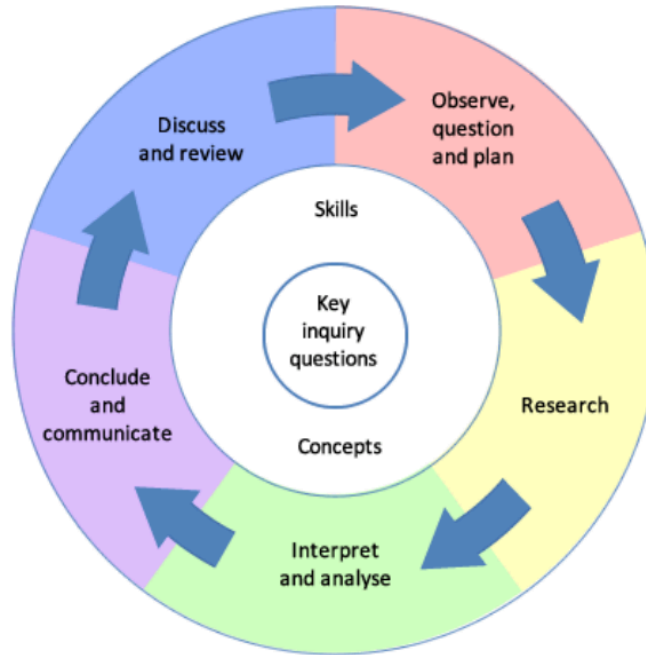
Creating a Historical Inquiry

1. What were some important events that were going that provides context for other people to better understand the event? Link to some sources that describe them.


2. Describe the actual event. Again, link to a source that describes it.
