**Meal Prices:** The board reviewed Food Service Director, Connie Evenson's recommendations for meal prices for the 2023-2024 school year. All students receive one free breakfast and one free lunch. Recommended prices are as follows: \$3.00, Adult breakfast and \$5.00, Adult lunch; Milk Break prices - \$80 annually, \$40 a semester; Snack Break - \$100 annually, \$50 a semester. Motion by Mary KW Langan, second by Jim Berens to set the 2023-2024 prices as stated above: Motion carried (6-0).
