You have the right to request that we delete any or all of the data we hold on you at any time. The only reason we would not do this is if it would result in us breaching other legal or regulatory obligations, but we would inform you of this at the time.

You have the right to withdraw consent at any time. This wouldn't affect any use of data up to that point, but it would have immediate effect from when we receive your request.
