“Clover Connect” is a **NEW** Stevens County 4-H Program that will serve to match 4-H youth with an older member who will help provide guidance and mentorship throughout the 4-H year. Utilizing hands-on engagement, mentors will help provide a positive learning experience in project areas relating to both static and livestock. They can also assist you at the Stevens County Fair with 4-H livestock shows and general entry day!

WHO:

- **MENTEE:** Any Cloverbud, 1st or 2nd year member, anyone trying a project for the first time
- **MENTOR:** Anyone that has been in Stevens County 4-H for a minimum of 3 years and is grade 7 or older.

WHERE: 4-H youth will connect with their mentor at least once a month. Gatherings may become more frequent if the need arises (working with livestock, etc. or prepping for the county fair).

WHEN: 4-H youth can connect with their mentor at club gatherings or any other place that is convenient for both members.
