

Hello [Name of Member of Congress],

I am calling to express my absolute disapproval of the NSA's unconstitutional and unaccountable domestic surveillance program.

Collecting information about my personal e-mails, phone calls, internet searches, and audio and video activities is a fundamental breach of my First and Fourth Amendment rights.

This type of blanket data collection by the government erodes essential and constitutionally protected American values. Furthermore, the body of secret surveillance law that has developed in an attempt to justify this type of domestic surveillance is antithetical to democracy. The NSA's domestic spying program is not the American way.

I am calling you to demand that you take immediate action in Congress to halt this surveillance and provide a full public account of the NSA's and the FBI's data collection programs. I am also asking that you:

1. Create a special committee to investigate, report, and reveal to the public the full extent of domestic spying.
2. Reform (a) Section 215 of the USA PATRIOT Act (b) the State Secrets Privilege and the scope of government classification authority, and (c) the FISA Amendments Act.
3. Hold accountable any public official who has lied to Congress regarding the nature or extent of these programs
