Tips for conferences....

1. If a student has a poor grade, make sure his/her parents are aware of that prior to walking in the door.
2. Clearly express that you want to help their child succeed. It is more effective to work with parents than against them.
3. Dress professionally.
4. Listen to parents. While you are the expert, parents want to feel that you value their input.
5. Provide every parent with a document that provides relevant information and can be used as a guide for the conference. For example:
 - a. Contact Information (voicemail, email)
 - b. Grading Scale/Late Work Policy
 - c. Classroom Expectations
 - d. Tentative Pacing Guide
 - e. Suggestions/Tips to improve a grade in _____ class.

\$10 entry fee. 100% will go to Clare Business Gift Cards for Prizes.

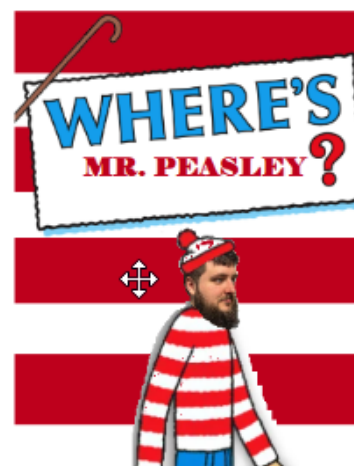
All prizes will be awarded through a raffle on December 19th at noon.
