## ◆ Senior Dues

If you have not ordered your Cap and Gown you must do so immediately (\$200). You have 2 options:

- By mail: If you pay by mail you need to put on a piece of paper: your name, Brookwood High School, your gender, your height, your weight and a check for \$200. Then mail to:

- *Any Senior Dues paid March 30<sup>th</sup> or later will have an additional \$25 shipping charge and your Cap and Gown will be shipped directly to your home.*

## ◆ Senior Congratulatory Yard Signs:

Senior Yard Signs were ordered during Fall Semester. Please pay attention to communications via ParentSquare, Saddle Up, and PTSA for details on when/where to pickup the yard sign.

◆ **Cap and Gown Delivery Dates:** Below is the delivery schedule for Cap and Gowns. Please note that students may only pick up their cap and gown, therefore they will NOT be allowed to pick it up for a friend.

- **If Senior Dues are Paid by March 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 PM:** Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> during all lunches.
  - If you do not receive your cap and gown on the 1<sup>st</sup>, please see Mrs. Thompson in B212, before/after school.
- **If Senior Dues are paid March 30<sup>th</sup> or later:** Cap and Gowns will be shipped directly to your home with an additional \$25 shipping charge added to your order. These will be shipped out in the order they are received.

◆ **Honor Stoles** for honor graduates (90 and above averages) are on sale and the cost is \$35. You can pay on **MyPaymentsPlus** or with a **check** made out to **BHS (please include Senior's name on the memo line)**. If paying by check, Seniors can deliver the check to room B212 or drop it off at the Welcome Desk in an envelope with Attention: Erin Thompson written on the outside and Senior's Name on the memo line.

- **Potential Honor Grads may still qualify for an honor stole at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.**  
Once all grades have been posted at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, the Curriculum Office will determine if you have reached the threshold to be considered an Honor Graduate. If you take some or all classes through Dual Enrollment, then you must come to the Counseling Office, A-1, between May 9<sup>th</sup> and May 16<sup>th</sup> and submit a printed report of your final college course grades from your Banner account. Potential Honor Grads who qualify will be able to purchase a stole for \$35 (**cash only**) at Graduation Practice the morning of May 20<sup>th</sup>. (Please note that Potential Honor Grads **will not be noted** in the Graduation Program, but they will be announced as an Honor Grad at the Graduation Ceremony.)

◆ March 28<sup>th</sup> – **Prom** is at the Ballroom at the Carlos Center (2500 Clairmont Rd, Atlanta, GA 30329) from 8:00 – 11:00. You can purchase tickets on GoFan for \$80 through March 1<sup>st</sup>. Beginning March 2<sup>nd</sup>, tickets increase to \$110. Your student ID will be the access code to purchase tickets on GoFan. **Tickets are**

**nonrefundable AND nontransferable!** Please note that all dates must be UNDER 21 years old and you will need an ID and your GoFan ticket to enter Prom (NO SCREENSHOTS ACCEPTED).

- ◆ April 20<sup>th</sup> – April 24<sup>th</sup> – Senior Week
  
- ◆ April 24<sup>th</sup> – **Senior Picnic** during 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> periods on the Practice Field. This has been paid for as part of your Senior Dues. The theme is a Hawaiian Luau so dress appropriately for the picnic.
  
- ◆ April 27<sup>th</sup> – **Honors Night** at 7pm at Brookwood High School. The honor stoles will be presented at the ceremony. If you receive an invitation for honors night, then you need to be at the school by 6:15. If you do not attend, students should pick up their honor stole from Mrs. Thompson in B212.
  
- ◆ May 17<sup>th</sup> – **Baccalaureate Service** at Cannon United Methodist Church at 3:00 p.m.. Seniors need to be there at 2:30 in the Fellowship Hall to line up. Do not bring Purses or Phones!!!! This is not a required event. **SEE ATTACHED FLYER**

  - Seniors will be required to pick up their Senior Letters and Graduation Wristbands at the end of practice before being dismissed to go home.
  - Graduation Practice is held outdoors in the stadium, so please be sure you hydrate and wear sunscreen to practice.
