

## Advanced & Accelerated Math and Gifted ELA Information for Transfer Students

By default, all students new to District 34 are placed in grade level courses. If your child was part of advanced or accelerated math (in grades 4-8) or gifted ELA (in grades 4-8) programming in their previous school, please reach out to us as soon as possible so we can determine the best course for your child in District 34. Incoming 3rd graders will automatically be part of the identification process if they are here when school starts in August.*
