As effort to increase quality articles, authors are recommended to take advantage of **results literature review (literature review)** For support argumentation, good in introduction (the need for study done) and in **discussion** (compared to with findings study previous / existing theories).

The script use style directly and brief. Avoid complex and ambiguous sentences. Define in a way short all term possible techniques Not yet general for reader. Explain abbreviation used at the beginning emergence. For example: Problem Based Learning (PBL).

Tips to explain your research:

1. Begin the Introduction by providing a brief description of the background to the problem being researched.
2. State the purpose of the investigation. The purpose of your research is the most important part of the introduction.
3. Establish the significance of your work: Why is it necessary to conduct this research?
4. Introduce the reader to relevant literature. Don't provide a complete history of the topic. Only cite previous work that has a direct bearing on the current issue. (Current state-of-the-art, relevant research to justify the novelty of the manuscript.)
5. State a gap analysis or novelty statement.
6. Clearly state your hypothesis, the variables studied, and summarize the methods used.
7. Define any abbreviations or special/regional terms.

completeness (you need to provide adequate details so that reader know what happened).

2. Explain instrumentation;
3. Describe the procedure and if relevant, the timeframe;
4. Describe the analysis plan;
5. Describe any approaches to ensuring validity and reliability;
6. Describe the statistical tests and comparisons made; ordinary statistical methods should be used without comment; for advanced or modified methods may require literature citations, and;
7. Describe the scope and/or limitations of the methodology you used.

In the context of social science, it is important to always give enough information so that other researchers can adopt or replicate your methodology. For Information, this is very important especially when method new has developed or use innovative from methods that have been There is used. Lastly, please avoid making sub-section in Method.

Results and Discussion Section aim to convey your findings as well give interpretation and/or opinion, explain impact from findings generated, and recommendations for future research. Function mainly is to give the answer on questions raised in Introduction, explaining method results support answer and how answer in accordance with understanding about topic. Discussion viewed as part main from the writing. Discussion will always connect with introduction through question study or the proposed hypothesis and the literature that has been reviewed, but no only copy or compile repeat introduction; discussion must always to describe How your research has increase understanding reader about problem study from point the last one left at the end introduction. To make your message clear, discuss must as short as Possible while still state, support, explain, and defend your answer with clear as well as discuss issues important and relevant others. The attention needs focused on providing comments and not repeat results. Tips:

1. State the Main Findings of the Study;
2. Explain the Meaning of the Findings and Why Findings Important;
3. Support answer with results. Explain How your results are related with hope and literature, with clear state Why results the can accepted and how results the consistent or in accordance with knowledge that has been published previously about topic the;
4. Connect Findings with Similar Studies;

5. Consider Explanation Alternative from Findings;
6. Implications of studies;
7. Acknowledge Study Limitations.

Discussion must focused on results and how results the can answer issues raised . Quote directly the amount more from three lines written with 1 space . 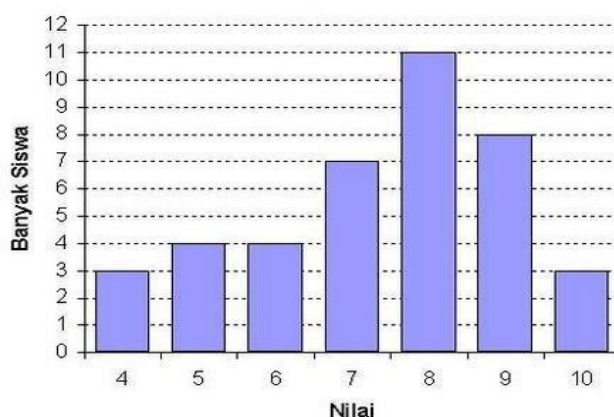
