


Fig 1. Example of a figure caption (figure caption)

Reference sources displayed in the reference list are sorted by letters of the alphabet (A-Z). Writing references in the text and writing reference sources in the reference list refer to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA Style). Writing a Bibliography must use a standard quoting application, such as Mendeley.
