

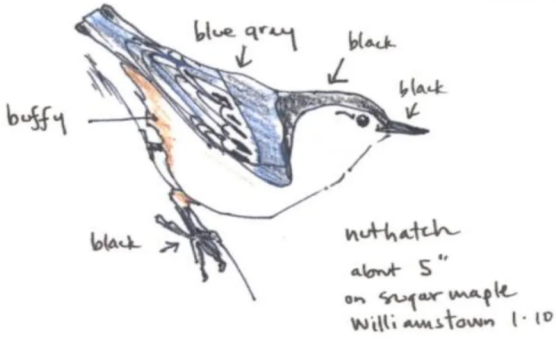
What's Outside Your Window? Or Nature Walk

Assignment Details

- Pick a time to observe what is going on outside of a window or choose to go on a nature walk at your home.
- The observation can last 5 minutes, an hour, or a day.
- Record what is happening: are people walking, are cars driving by, do you see any animals, what is going on with the weather, describe the scene.
- Include what sounds do you hear? How would our outdoor experience be without any sounds?
- Find a way to visualize the information you collect, consider any of these options:
 - Create a timeline
 - Create a chart
 - Create a collage
 - Draw a picture
 - Write a ½ page journal entry about what you observed, be as descriptive as possible. Consider how this observation looks different from what you may have observed a month or a year ago.
