Be it enacted by the Associated Students at the University of New Mexico that the following be amended in *(3605)* of the ASUNM *Lawbook*:**Section 3605. Outreach and Events Committee Event Approval**

~~A. The Outreach & Events Committee shall be required to submit all proposed event programming, along with a detailed budget, to the Full Senate for review and approval prior to any event. No event shall be executed, nor funds used, without prior approval by a majority vote of the seated Senate.~~

~~B. In cases where an event or expenditure is deemed urgent and time-sensitive, a proposal may be introduced as Special Business, subject to the rules and voting thresholds governing such designation under Senate procedures. Special Business proposals must be submitted no later than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the scheduled Full Senate meeting and must receive a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote to be opened for discussion.~~

~~C. The Vice President and President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall jointly oversee the implementation of this and ensure compliance with all related procedures.~~
