

Let's Chat

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Let's Chat (162899)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Daffodil Delight (119683); Basic White: (159276); Bee Mine DSP (162546)
- **Stamp Pads:** Sweet Sorbet (159216)
- **Tools:** Scalloped Contours Dies ((155560); Paper Snips Scissors (103579)
- **Miscellaneous:** Adhesive Backed Hearts & Flowers (162557); Sweet Sorbet ¼" Bordered Ribbon (162558); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)



Measurements:

- Daffodil Delight: 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"; 1" square
- Basic White: 3 ½" x 5" (crop with Scalloped Contour Die); 3 ¼" 1 ¼" (Phone receiver)
- Yellow DSP: 4" x 5 ¼"
- Red DSP: 1 ¼" x 4 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Measure, score, and cut the Daffodil Cardstock.
2. Using Sweet Sorbet Ink, stamp the phone base and "Hey" stamp onto the large Basic White panel and then crop with the Scalloped Contour die. You may find it easier to crop the White panel first and then stamp.
3. Stamp the Receiver onto the small panel of Basic White and trim with Paper Snips Scissors.
4. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to attach the Yellow DSP panel to card front. Next, add the Red DSP Panel with Glue.
5. Use Glue to attach the small Daffodil Delight Square – position about ½" from fold of card.
6. Use a glue dot adhere a small piece of the ribbon onto the Daffodil Delight Square.
7. Add the Scalloped Contour Shape and the phone receiver to card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Embellish with a flower from the Adhesive Backed Hearts & Flowers packet.
