Grading Policy:

First grade uses a numerical average system to configure grades. The numerical system is as follows:

90-100 = A

80-89 = B

70-79 = C

Below 70 = F

Any assignment/assessment that receives a failing grade can be retaken. The highest grade the student can recieve for these assignments is a 70.

Grade Calculation

There are 3 categories of grades for first grade. They are Classwork, Assessments, and Homework. Classwork is worth 60% of the overall grade for each grading period. Assessments are worth 40% of the overall grade. Homework will sometimes be assigned. Homework grades will be used to add bonus points to assignments and assessments.

Content:

- Reading: Letters/sounds, blending phonemes to read words, reading words in sentences and stories, story comprehension-story elements, main ideas, story sequencing.
- <u>Writing/ Handwriting</u>: writing simple sentences, planning, writing, and editing stories with a beginning/middle/end, basic grammar-parts of speech, sentence structure, punctuation, using space properly to make letters and words.
- <u>Math</u>: number recognition, counting to 120, skip count by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s, base ten blocks to represent numbers, basic addition and subtraction, shapes, time, and money.
- Science: plants, weather, seasons, day/night, animal life cycles,
- <u>Social Studies</u>: rules, community, our neighborhood, being a good neighbor/citizen, state and national symbols

Safety and Security

- <u>Masks</u>: At this time the district has mandated that all staff, students and parents wear masks while inside school district buildings and buses.

Dresscode

TOPS

- · Color: Navy or white
