All adult participants are mandatory reporters. Reporting violations may be made anonymously and there are no fees for reporting. We all are part of promoting a culture of safety through education, listening, and speaking up.

Reporting procedures

Procedures for reporting concerns involving alleged violations of the MAAPP, the SafeSport Code, or the Athlete Safety Policy:

- a. For concerns that are non-sexual in nature, use the U.S. Ski & Snowboard [File a Report – Other Misconduct](#) form available on its website.
- b. For concerns regarding sexual misconduct, report to the [U.S. Center for SafeSport](#) and the authorities if a minor is involved.
