Specify dates: January 1-31 of 2000, 2010, 2020, 2024

The <u>Zeeland Record</u> and <u>Coopersville Observer</u>, along with other West Michigan community and business newspapers, are in the <u>Special Collections</u> at Seidman House, <u>Regional and Historical Publications</u> collection in paper form and do not leave that building.

## Policies:

- Contact them before going over (see emails below): The staff gets items for you
  and notifying them of a visit in advance ensures they can have the materials
  ready.
- Know what you want to see. Make sure you've noted the newspaper title and the month and year you'd like to view (use the links above).
- Bring the right supplies. Pencils, paper, laptop, phone and/or camera are all recommended for taking notes and non-flash photographs. Don't forget any charging cords if your visit will be lengthy. Dress for the archives: archives are kept at a cooler temperature year-round, so consider wearing layers or bringing a sweater or jacket along.
- Because the materials are unique, we also require that you sign an agreement to abide by the policies (use pencil, don't bring food or drink, etc.)
- Virtual tour: Start at beginning; Regional History starts at 1:29.
