1. Where is the residency situated?

The residency is situated in Lagos, Nigeria

2. Is travel cost covered by 1952 Africa for those coming from outside Lagos?

Yes, travel costs will be covered for selected artists to and fro the residency.

3. Can I come with my pet to the residency?

No, pets are not allowed at the residency.

4. How long does the residency lasts?

The residency lasts for eight (8) weeks.

5. Who is the call open to?

The call is open to all English-speaking artists in West Africa.

6. Is the call open to only visual artists?

No, the call is open to artists working across diverse mediums.

7. I have created some artworks in the past, but I have created only one recently that truly represents my artistic style. Which should I apply with?

We would advise you to use the work which both shows your evolution as an artist, as well as is most suited and relevant to the theme.

8. What are the start and end dates for the residency?

The residency starts in the first week of September and closes in the last week of October.

9. Will the selected artists receive stipends during the residency?

Yes, the selected artists will receive stipends during the residency.
