Bursting with aromas of fresh peach pie spiced with cinnamon and vanilla. Petrichor and fresh tilled soil provide a subtle and unique expression of place and vintage. The light red color from the pale grape skin provides an ethereal backdrop to the balanced tannins of this unique noble grape transplanted from Italy to a remote region of California. Crafted from grapes that ripen late in the coastal-influenced continental climate of the valley, this wine beautifully expresses the uniqueness of Humboldt County climate and soil.
