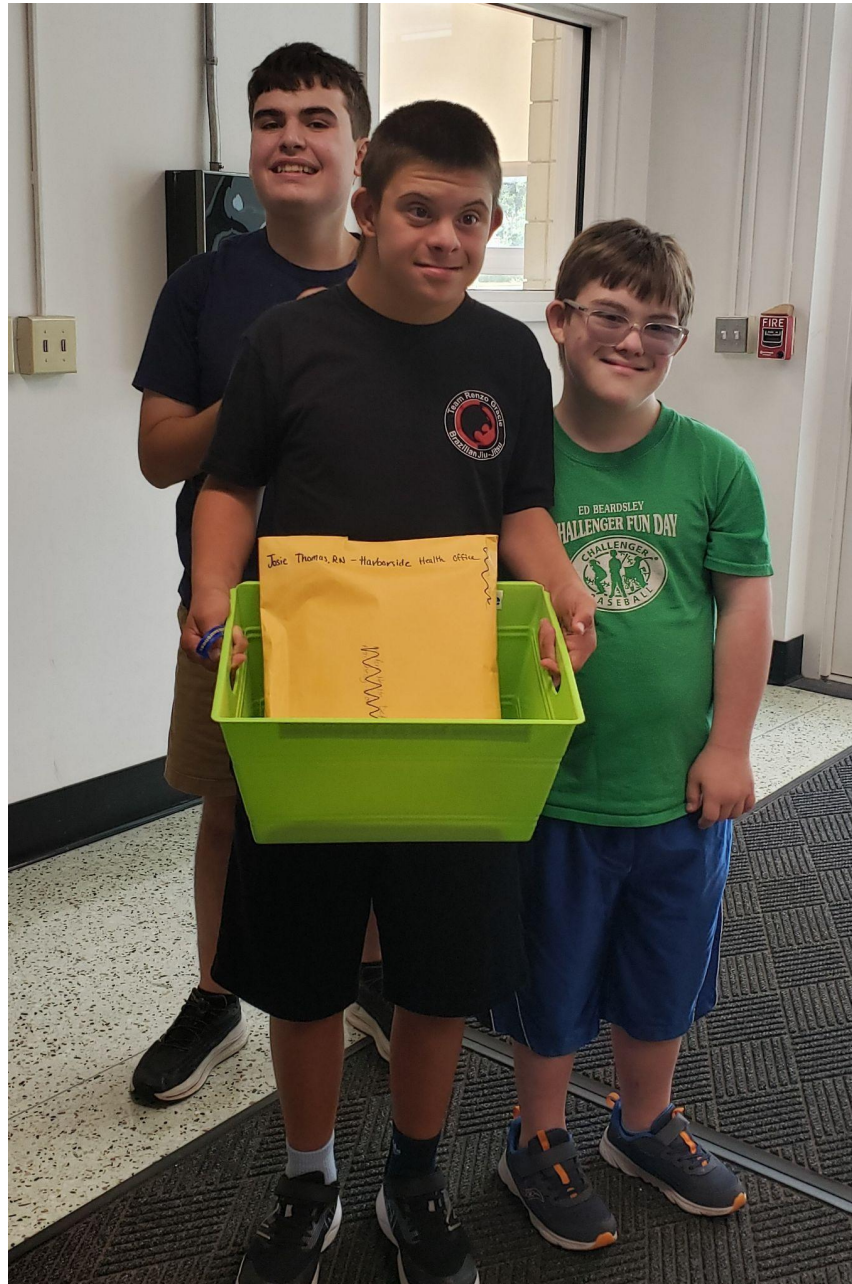
I am married and have three children, all of whom attend Milford Public Schools. I don't have a lot of free time, but when I do, I love to play the bass and guitar.”

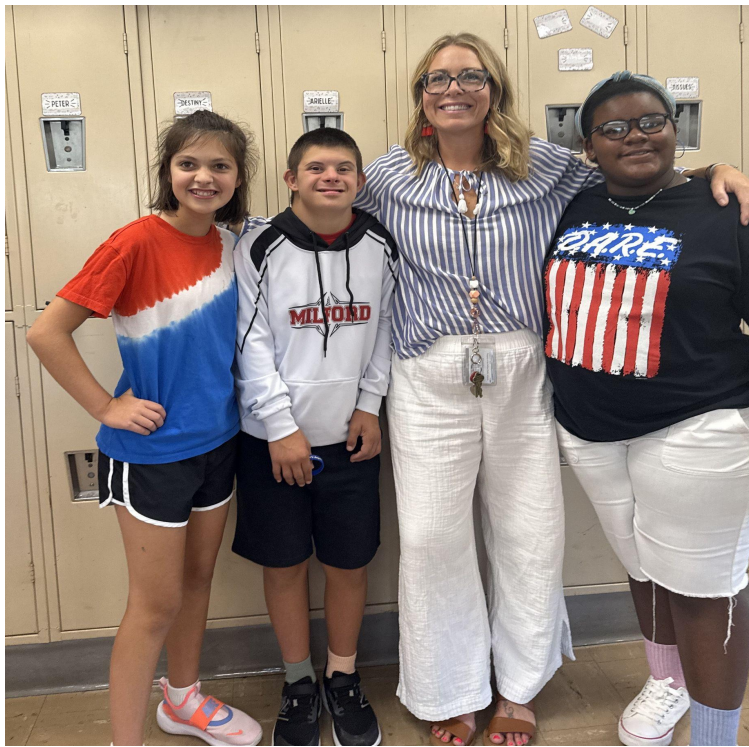

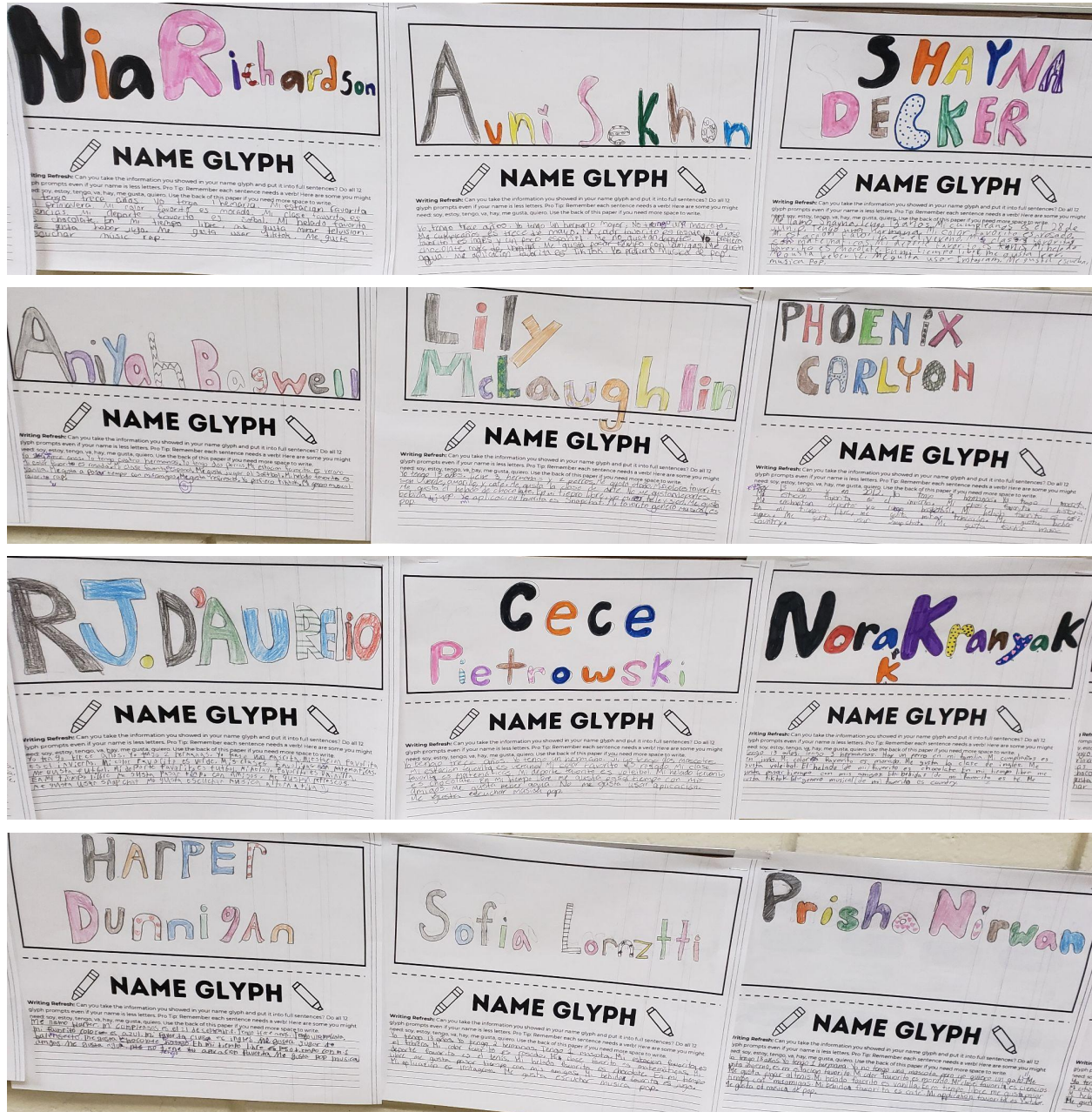
We donned red, white, and blue in remembrance of the events that took place on September 11, 2001.

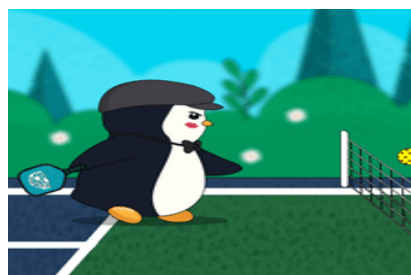

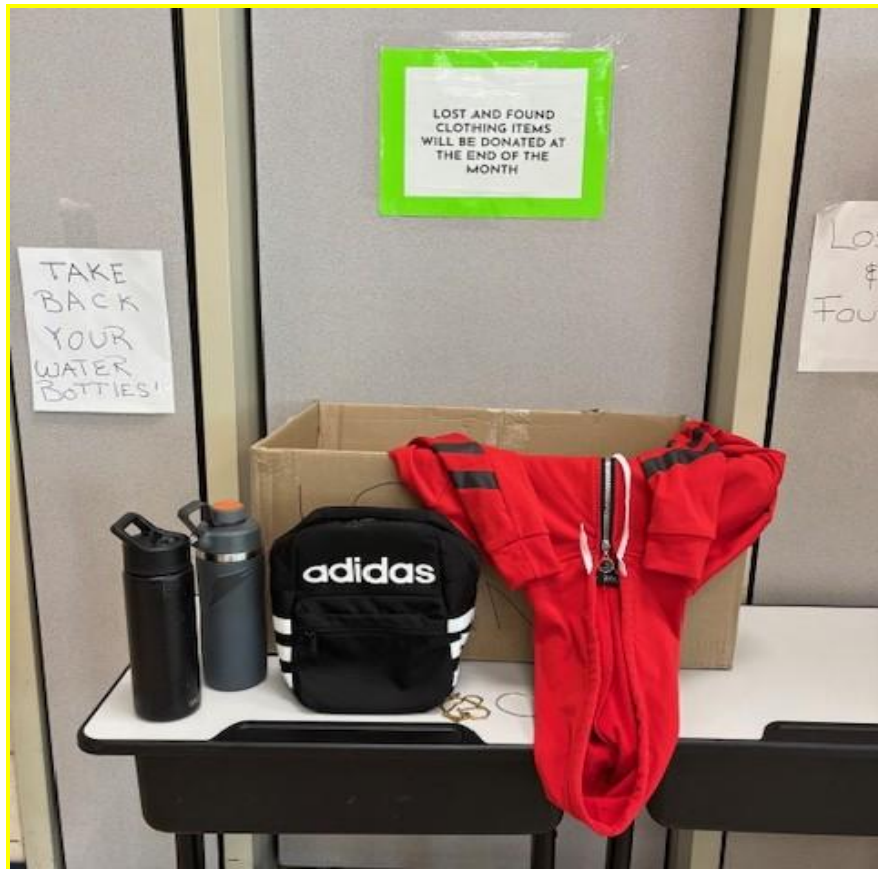
